December 31, 2013 the total studbook population exist out of 31.36.101 (168) animals. The living population 23.21.22 (66) animals.

December 31, 2013 the 23.21.22 specimens were kept at 14 locations. 1 in the Netherlands, 8 in Germany, 1 in Austria, 1 in France, 1 in Denmark, 1 in Belgium and 1 in Spain.
